Poster Contest Rules

- The Contest is open to all students grades K-6
- All entries must be an original creation, no “group” or “team” entries will be accepted.
- **ALL ENTRIES MUST HAVE A SUBMISSION FORM ATTACHED TO THE UPPER LEFT HAND CORNER OF THE POSTER. THE SUBMISSION FORM MUST BE COMPLETELY FILLED OUT OR THE POSTER WILL NOT BE JUDGED.** There is a form that must be filled out and attached to the back of the poster. Information on this form will not be revealed to the public and is only for use by YPC for parent notification if their child’s poster is one of the winners.
- **SOME POSTERS WILL BE DISPLAYED AT THE MERCED MALL BETWEEN Oct. 7th thru Oct. 20th.**

Collection Of Posters

Put all collected poster entries into a manila envelope. Entries should be sent to YOUR SCHOOL DISTRICT OFFICE for Inter-District mail. The front of the envelope should include school and teacher name and be addressed to the Young Patriot Challenge, MCOE Complex Bldg J-1 and **arrive no later than September 17, 2021.**

Judging and Awards

Students that win the countywide competition in 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in each category will receive awards of a medal with ribbon, a gift card and a certificate. The YPC committee will be judging the posters. The winners will be honored along with their parents at an Award Ceremony to be held on October 20, 2021. All students that enter will receive a Certificate of Achievement.

The posters will be judged according to the following criteria:

- Attention to theme
- Artistic excellence
- Adherence to contest rules
- Originality

Poster Construction and Dimensions

- Any type paper may be used
- The minimum size is **8.5” x 11”** and the maximum size is **11” x 17”**. **Any other sizes will be disqualified.**

Poster Themes by Grade and Category

K-3rd "Symbols of Liberty of our Nation.

For students in grades k-3rd we are looking for images that invoke the Symbol of Liberty, such as the Statue of Liberty, Bald Eagle, Liberty Bell, flag, etc. Please encourage students to pick symbols that inspire them personally.


4th- 6th "Symbols of our Nation.

For the older students we are looking for Symbols such as the Supreme Court Building, famous judges, Uncle Sam, the Constitution, pledge of allegiance, Lincoln statue, Washington monument, etc.

Poster Return Policy

Some posters submitted to the YPC will be publicly displayed. All posters submitted to YPC become the property of YPC and will not be returned.
