YOUNG PATRIOT CHALLENGE

Dear Teacher,

The *Young Patriot Challenge* (YPC) program is a countywide academic competition that was created by a committee of volunteers to help the schools of Merced County celebrate Constitution Week (September 17th-21st). For students in elementary school, we are having a *Poster contest*.

It is our hope that you will allow students time to engage in the activity (drawing the poster) as part of their classroom activities during Constitution week. **Please attach the submission form to the upper left front of the poster so that we can identify which classroom the poster comes from.** There is a form that must be attached to the back of the poster. This form will have the name and phone number of the parent/guardian of the child. None of this information will be revealed to the public.

Put all collected poster entries into a manila envelope. Entries should be sent to YOUR SCHOOL DISTRICT OFFICE for Inter-District mail. The front of the envelope should include school and teacher name and be addressed to the Young Patriot Challenge, MCOE Complex Bldg J-1 and **arrive no later than September 28, 2018**

Students that win the countywide competition will receive awards of a medal with ribbon, a gift card and a certificate. They will be honored along with their parents at an Award Ceremony to be held on October 24, 2018. All students that enter will receive a Certificate of Achievement.

Federal law requires all federally funded schools to teach lessons about the Constitution or have Constitution related activities during Constitution week, so why not make it fun.
